Day Ranger and **Rover** tickets provide you with the freedom to explore the North by train allowing you to hop on and off the train as many times as you wish.

As the name suggests, day ranger tickets are valid for one day, whereas rovers allow you to travel on four days out of eight consecutive days within the valid travel area or on seven consecutive days.

You can buy ranger and rover tickets from staffed ticket offices throughout the country, at ticket vending machines or from the conductor on the train. Some are available to purchase online.

Discounts are available on some of these tickets providing a 50% saving for children 5-15 years old and for holders of the 16-17 Saver railcard. Adult prices benefit from a one third discount for holders of other national railcards listed below:

- 26-30
- Two Together
- Disabled Persons
- Senior
- HM Forces*
- Veterans*
- Family & Friends*

**Children travelling with these railcard holders may benefit from 81% discount on the ticket price.*

Northern Explorer

Enjoy travel on all services operated by Northern. This ticket is available for one to four people for one to four days. Prices start at £35 for a ticket for one day for one person with greater savings for more days and more people. Children travel for 50% of the adult fare.

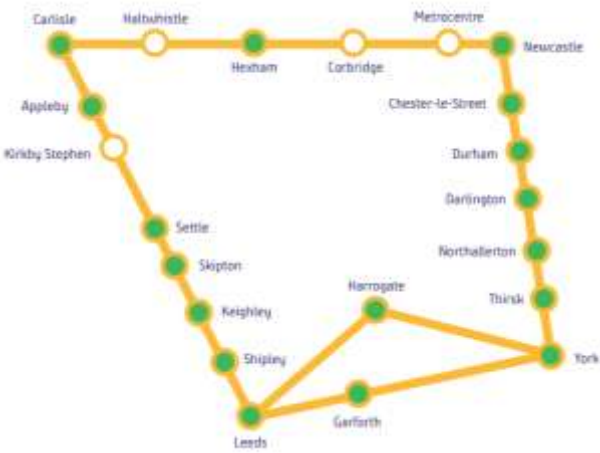

Cumbria Travel Pass

Available as one- or three-day tickets, you can use this ticket for travel on trains, buses and boats to explore the Lake District. Travel within the area of validity on Northern and Avanti trains, Stagecoach buses, the Ravenglass & Eskdale Railway, Windermere Cruises, Ullswater Steamers, and launches on Coniston and Derwentwater.

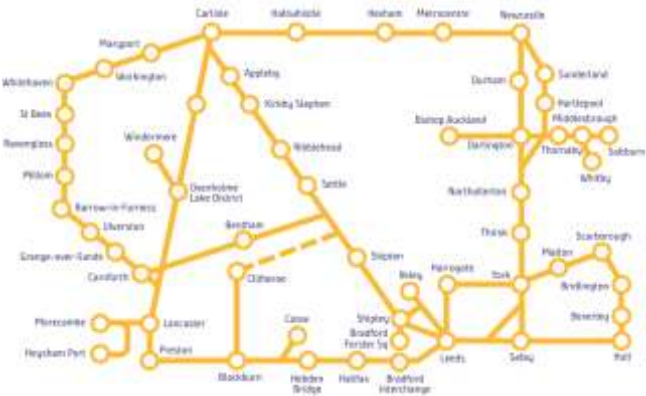

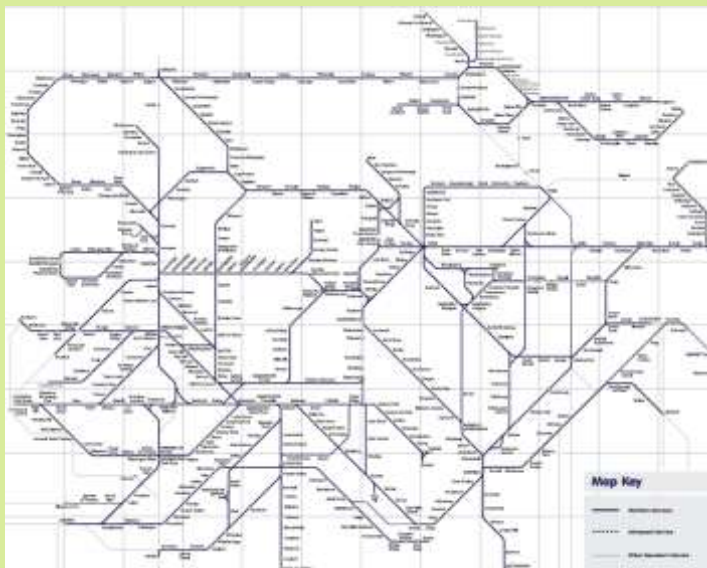
