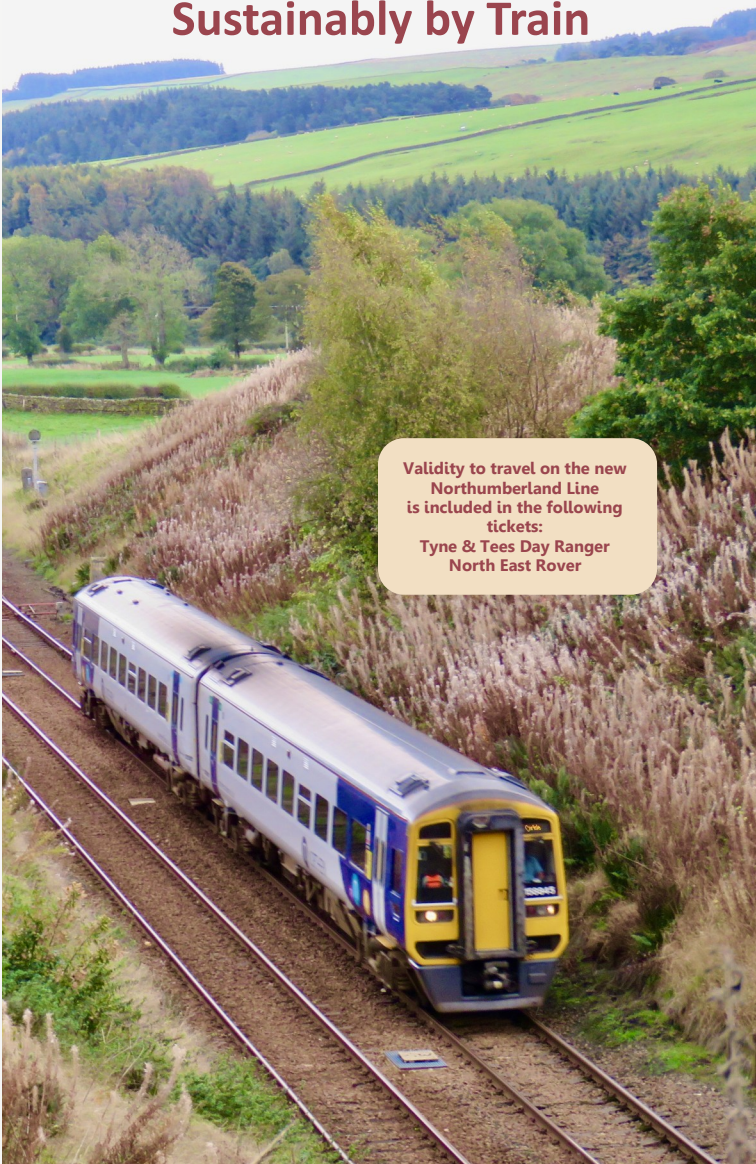

Day Ranger and **Rover** tickets provide you with the freedom to explore the North by train allowing you to hop on and off the train as many times as you wish.

As the name suggests, day ranger tickets are valid for one day, whereas rovers allow you to travel on four days out of eight consecutive days within the valid travel area or on seven consecutive days .

You can buy ranger and rover tickets from staffed ticket offices throughout the country, at ticket vending machines or from the conductor on the train**.

Discounts are available on most of these tickets. A 50% saving for children 5-15 years old and for holders of the 16-17 Saver card. Adult prices benefit from a one third discount for holders of other national railcards listed below:

- Two Together
- Disabled Persons
- Senior
- HM Forces*
- Veterans*
- Family & Friends*

**Children travelling with these railcard holders benefit from 81% discount on the ticket price.*

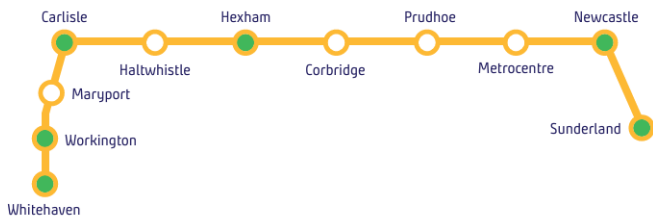

*** valid ticket to travel is required unless boarding at a station without ticket-issuing facilities . Some rover tickets may not be available on ticket vending machines.*

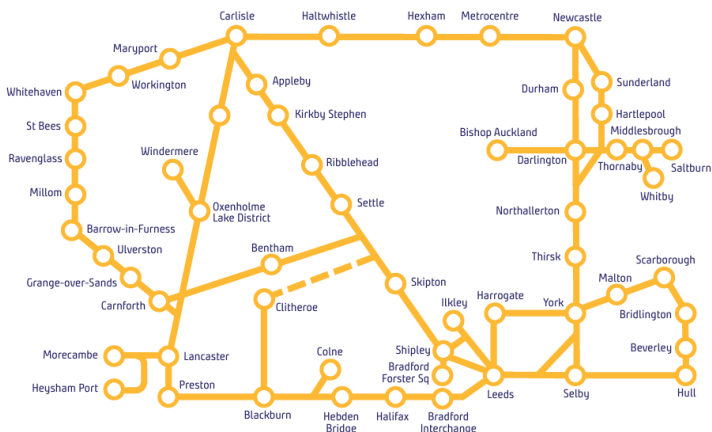
HADRIAN'S WALL COUNTRY LINE DAY RANGER



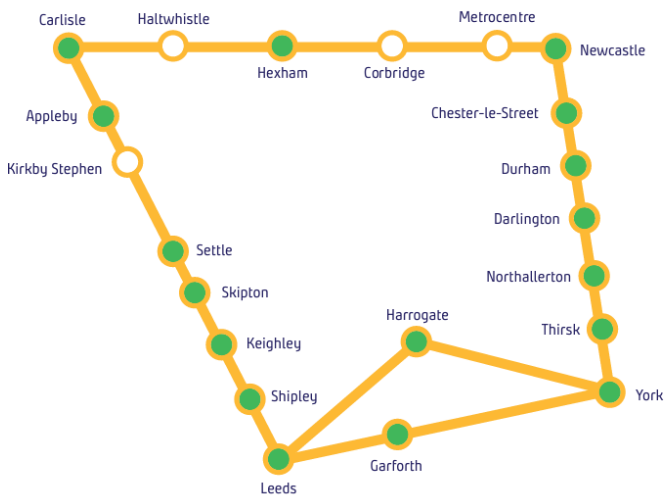
TYNE & TEES DAY RANGER

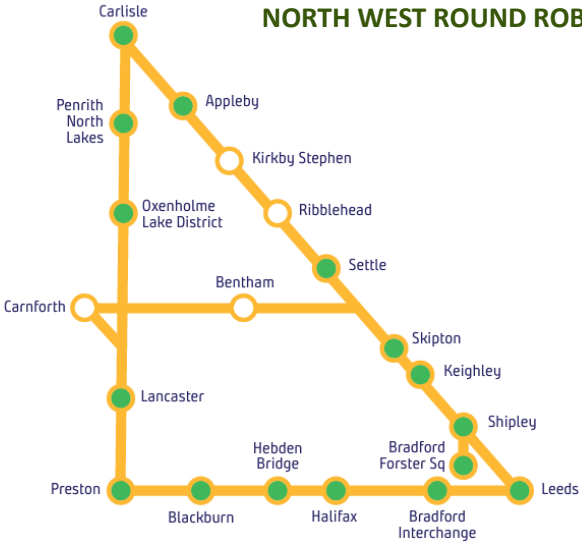
